Residents in Carbon Hill, Alabama and West Delray Beach, Florida are going to be the guinea pigs in an effort by telecom companies to retire the country's aging telephone system.








Vendor's offering "Pots" line that uses Fiber or Cable, not Copper (VoIP Solution)



Ticking Time Bomb - Landlines POTS (Copper) vs. VolP






