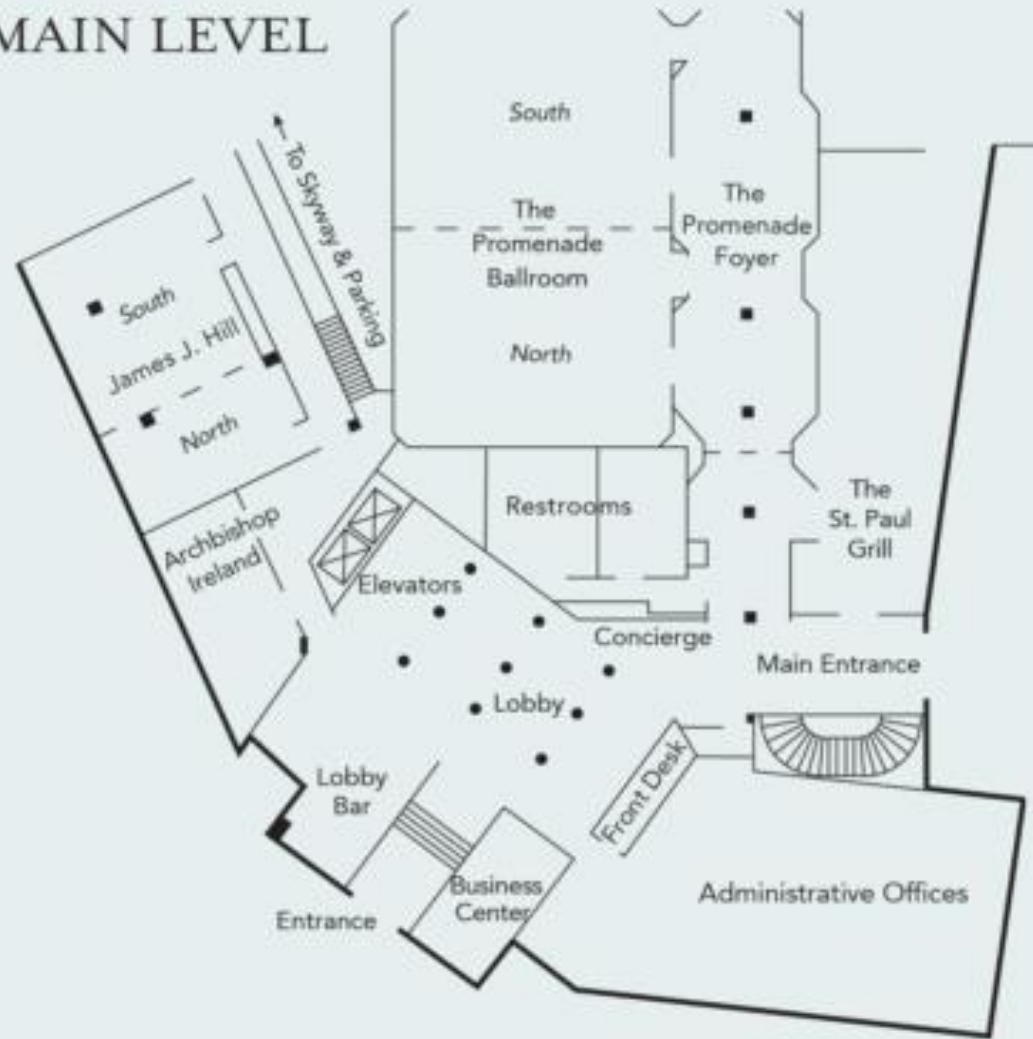

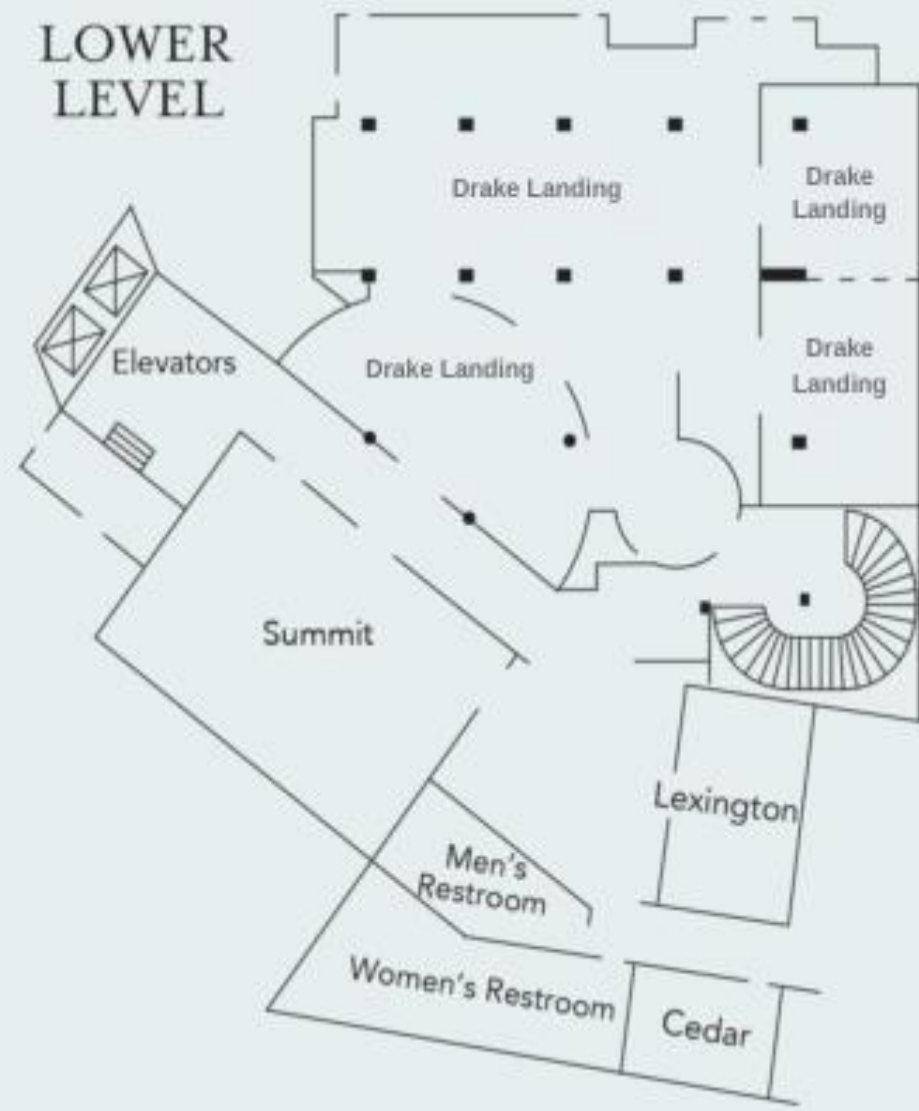

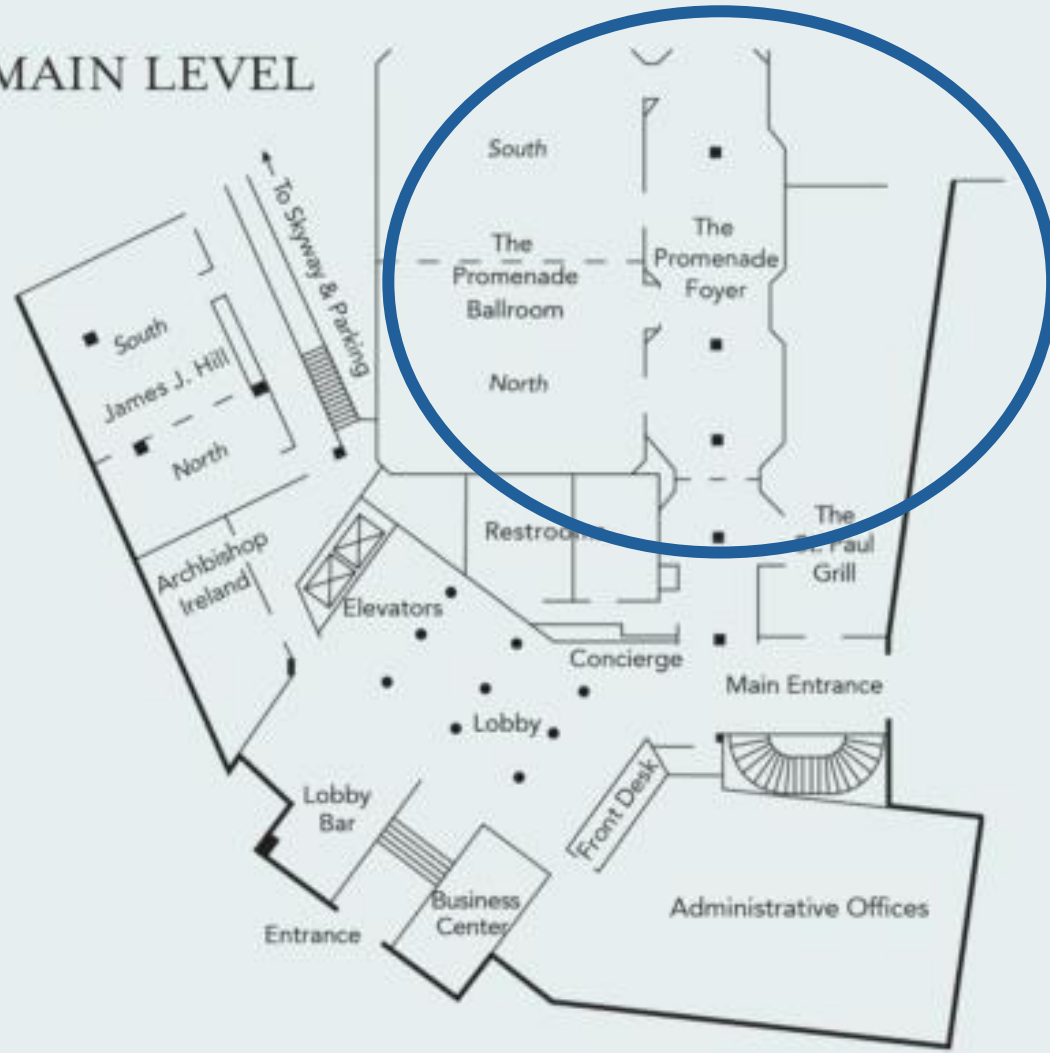

Fun Facts about the Hotel

- The national historic landmark Saint Paul Hotel has stood unrivaled as the best luxury hotel in the Twin Cities since 1910. The hotel has hosted some of America's preeminent figures including presidents, royalty, celebrities, and gangsters. Charles Lindberg returned to St. Paul from his trans Atlantic flight in 1927 and a dinner is given for him at the hotel. During St. Paul's gangster era (1920s-1930s), Leon Gleckman, known as the "Al Capone of St. Paul," maintains his headquarters for business dealings in a suite at The Saint Paul Hotel. Mike Malone, a U.S. Treasury Department official who infiltrated Al Capone's syndicate in Chicago, also rents a room at the hotel to observe Gleckman's activities. A young band leader named Lawrence Welk began playing in the hotel on Saturday nights in 1937. Gene Autry checks into the hotel for eight days in 1947 with his horse, Champion, for a rodeo.
